What is Accounting Career Fair?

Accounting Career Fair is an annual event held at RIT in which local CPA firms, corporations and professional organizations are invited to attend a formal open house sponsored by NGA. This event provides the opportunity for recruiters from attending organizations to initially meet prospective employees from the pool of interested RIT students.
